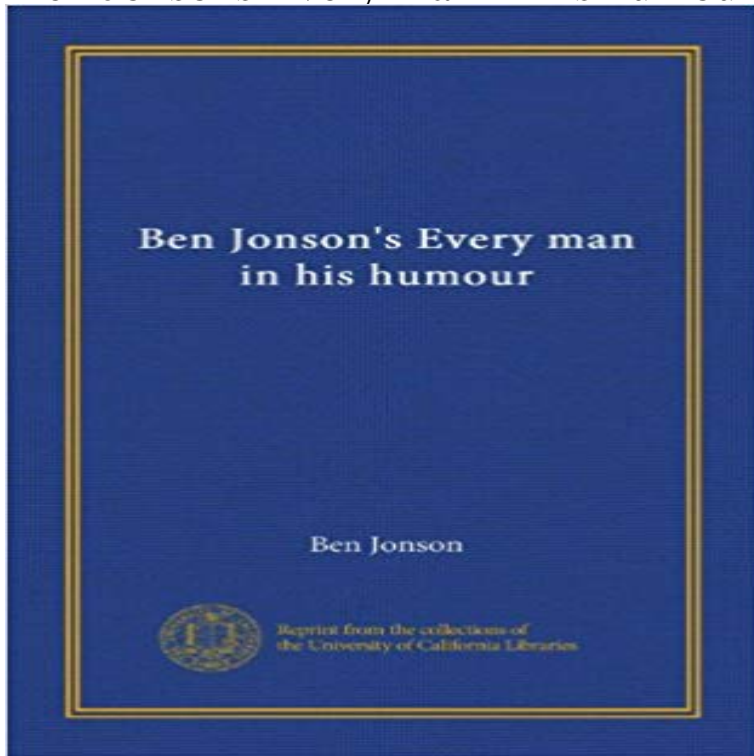


Ben Jonsons Every man in his humour (Vol-1)
