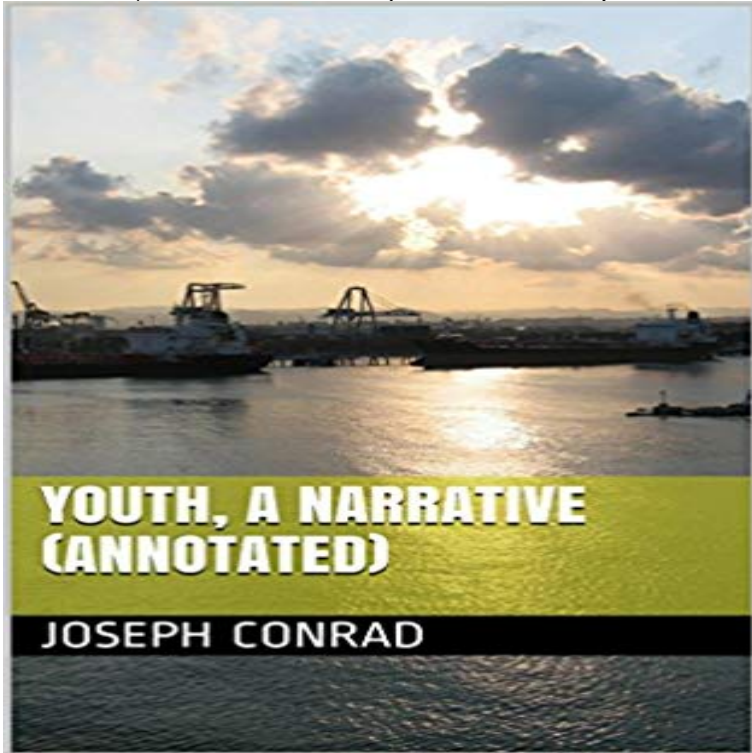


Youth, a Narrative (Annotated)
