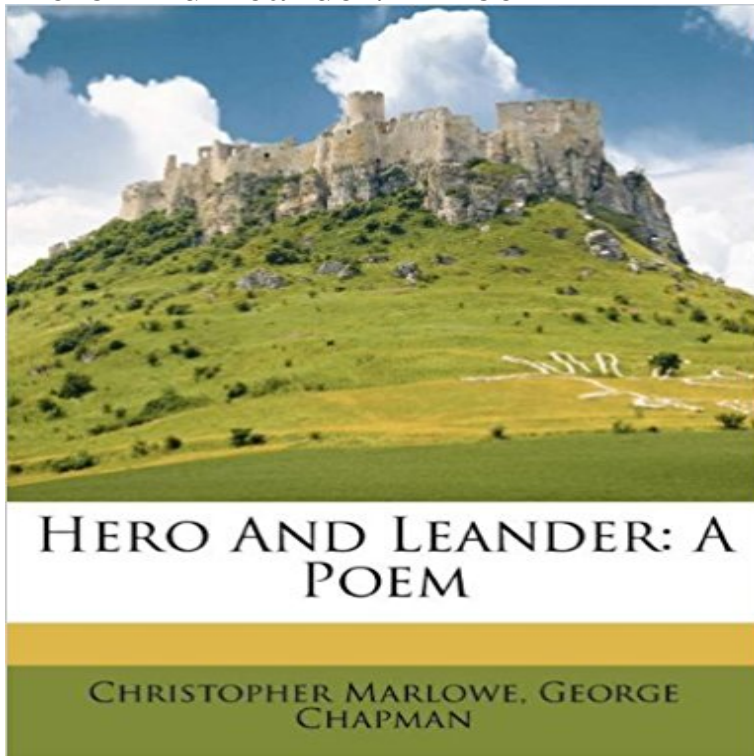


## Hero And Leander: A Poem
