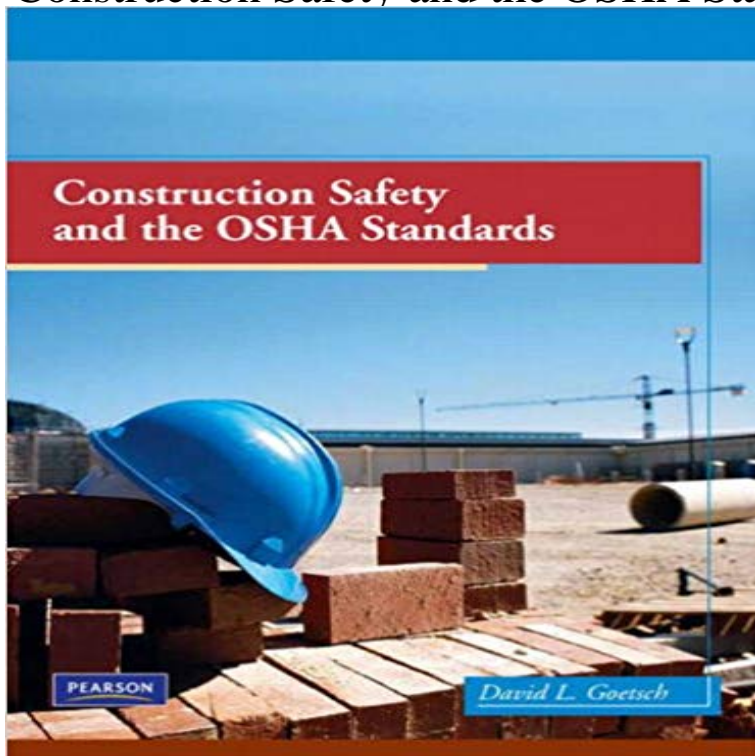


Construction Safety and the OSHA Standards
