


Saadi: The Divan

Saadi was a great traveller who spent forty years on the road throughout the Middle-East, North Africa and India and many of the incidents he experienced he wrote down in his two most famous works when he finally returned to his beloved birth-place The Rose Garden (Gulistan) and The Orchard (Bustan).
