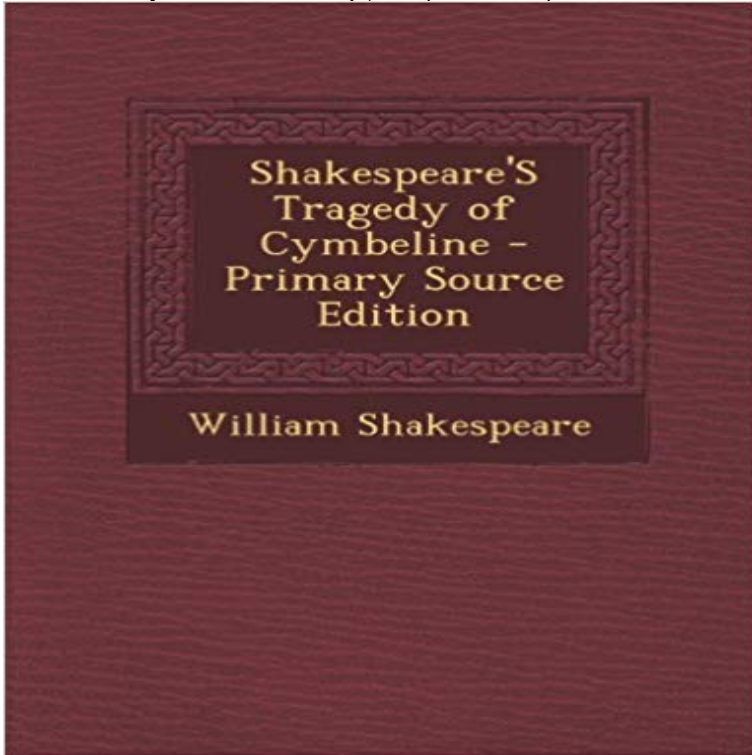


## Shakespeares Tragedy of Cymbeline - Primary Source Edition
